ENERGY RESEARCH IN SOUTH AFRICA – SANERI AND THE RESEARCH AREAS FUNDED.

The South African National Energy Research Institute (SANERI) was established in 2006 with a brief to fund public interest energy R&D. The company allocated R40m to research projects, R1.5m to bursaries and R7.5m to energy research chairs at local universities. The SANERI CEO, Kadri Nassiep will examine the research areas being funded, and give an overview of the research topics being investigated by SANERI bursary holders.
